Reducing Inflation

PATH TO VICTORY

Florida House District 38, covering Winter Springs, Casselberry, Fern Park, and Altamonte Springs, is a growing suburban district with 42,339 registered Republican voters. The Republican electorate is majority White, with 33,220 voters, alongside a significant Hispanic population of 5,554 and smaller but significant Asian, Black, and multiracial communities. Gender is nearly evenly split, and the district includes a large number of older voters, particularly those over 55, who turn out reliably. At the same time, younger voters make up a meaningful portion of the electorate and represent an important opportunity for engagement.

While District 38 has historically leaned Republican, the district's suburban makeup means elections can be competitive. The 2020 Republican primary drew 13,633 voters, showing a solid base of Republican engagement, though recent cycles have seen limited contested primaries. Voters here care about practical issues: safer neighborhoods, strong schools, and keeping costs manageable for families. These priorities are particularly important as the district grows and diversifies.

Marcus Hyatt's background in education, law enforcement, and the legal field positions him to connect with voters across the district. By focusing on community safety, quality education, and economic relief for families, his campaign can strengthen Republican support while appealing to moderate and independent voters who are focused on local results. With its mix of reliable GOP voters, engaged suburban families, and a growing diverse population, District 38 is an opportunity for Republicans to maintain and expand their representation in Tallahassee.
